2. Brazilian Product Certificate (CPB) issued by ANCINE;
3. Foreign co-producer information declared in CPB.

Brazilian feature film projects that have reported as foreign co-producer companies those that allocated resources through the mechanisms of tax incentives established by Brazilian Law were not considered international co-productions.
